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Ford Truck Renovation Project

Training and Education

Approximately twenty Global management and support staff recently received a comprehensive ½ day training session entitled **Managing Multiple Projects, Objectives and Deadlines.** This course was provided by "Skillpath Seminars" and was delivered at Global's in-house classroom facility. This training is a continuation of Global's commitment to providing its employees with ongoing training in order to develop our staff's professional skills. A total of ten in-house sessions are expected to be delivered during 2006. Training will include management skills, professional development, customer service, technical development, and financial topics relevant to Global's operations.
